

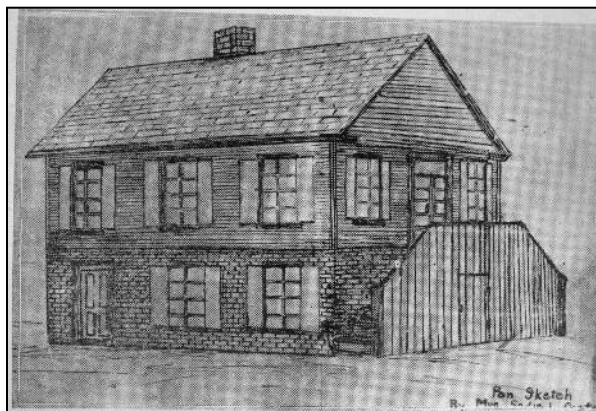
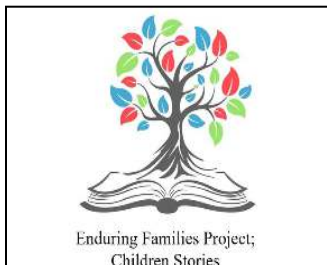


BIG QUESTION: What was it like living on the wharf?
